#### Staff updates

We are actively trying to recruit more GPs to enable us to increase appointment availability for our ever growing population.

We have recruited a long term Locum Dr Hussain, who joins us this month. We are sad to be saying goodbye to our Advance Nurse Practitioner Sue. We would like to wish Sue all the very best and thank her for all of her hard work.

#### **Social Prescribing**

We welcome to the team Charlotte as our new Social Prescriber. The role of a Social Prescriber is to help patients to improve their health, wellbeing and social welfare by connecting them to community services, which may be run by the council or a local charity. For example, signposting patients who have been diagnosed with dementia to local dementia support groups. The role of the Social Prescriber is becoming increasingly popular in GP Surgeries across the UK, they help reduce pressure on GPs and aim to streamline patient access to the help and support they require.

#### **Healthy Living Classes**

Lets Get Moving is coming to Eye Community Centre. A free 8 week course starting the 8th July between 10 and 11am. The course is an introduction to activities with a qualified instructor and can be adapted to cater for any needs. Reserve a space by contacting Eye Medical Practice who can refer you to Charlotte our Social Prescriber.

#### **Leaving Octagon**

You may be aware that on the 1st April 2021 the process began for the demerger of Octagon Medical Practice. Because we are the lead site for the Octagon Group, we will be the last practice to leave Octagon. We hope that the demerger will be finalised by the 31st December 2021. Moving forward from January 2022 we will be forming a new smaller surgery group with the Jenner Health Centre in Whittlesey. We will share more information about this in due course.

#### Online Services & Medication Request

We try to encourage our patients to use online services. If you would like to be set up for online services, please telephone reception and we can organise this for you. Online services are a great way of managing and keeping track of your medication requests, pre-booking GP appointments and also updating your contact details. Please remember all routine medication requests will take 48 hours to be processed and sent to the pharmacy of your choice. Orders for medication can be made 7 days prior to their due date, which allows plenty of time for requests to be processed for you.

#### **Covid 19 Pandemic**

We have all been living and working through unprecedented times and would like to thank all of our patients for their kind support and patience during the pandemic. Clinicians and staff have been working continually in the practice to care for our patients and also supporting evening and weekend Covid vaccination clinics. We are currently working on catching up on work that had to be postponed over the past year such as long term condition reviews and medication reviews. We have employed a new member of staff to our administration team to assist in the recall scheme and she will be contacting patients to make their appointments. You may be asked to attend another site to get tests done e.g. the City Care Centre for blood tests. This enables us to keep appointments at the practice for patients that are unable to access services elsewhere.

The receptionists are often able to offer you appointments at the weekend or in the evening at other sites if we are unable to accommodate your request, they will always do their best to help you and explain what options are available to them at the time they are looking.

We have been successfully operating Telephone Triage since the pandemic and will be continuing this process, any appointments that are required to be converted to a face to face appointment will be arranged with the clinician during this telephone call. The reception team are unable to book a face to face appointment with a GP or Nurse Practitioner. Face-to-face appointments required with the Practice Nurses and Health Care assistants can be made via Reception.

#### **Zero Tolerance Policy.**

We operate a zero tolerance policy at the Practice in line with the NHS. If you have any concerns about the Practice please contact our patient Liaison Officer Lynnette Brennan who is based at the Practice.

GPs and staff have a right to care for others without fear of being attacked, abused or treated badly in any way. To successfully provide our services a mutual respect between staff and patients has to be in place. All our staff aim to be polite, helpful, and sensitive to all patients' individual needs and circumstances. We would respectfully remind patients that very often staff could be confronted with a multitude of varying and sometimes difficult tasks and situations, all at the same time.

However, aggressive behaviour, be it physical, verbal or online, will not be tolerated and may result in you being removed from the practice list and, in extreme cases, the Police being contacted.

In order for the practice to maintain good relations with our patients we would like to ask all our patients to read and take note of the occasional types of behaviour we see that are unacceptable:

- Using bad language, shouting or raising of voices at practice staff.
- Any physical violence towards any member of our team or other patients.
- Verbal abuse towards staff or patients in any form including shouting.
- Online abuse including posts on social media.
- Racist, xenophobic, sexist, homophobic or other intolerant language, discrimination or sexual harassment will never be tolerated.
- Persistent or unrealistic demands that cause stress to staff will not be accepted. Requests will be met wherever possible and explanations given when they cannot be met.
- Being perceived to bully or manipulate a staff member to obtain something.

## Neighbourhood Watch Eye & Eye Green

I am sure that we are all looking forward to the final phase of lockdown, and the return to how we used to be over 18 months ago. Hopefully we can enjoy a little more freedom over the summer months.



At Neighbourhood Watch we are aware that even with this freedom a number of people will still require help, and will find it very difficult to start venturing out again. We are here to help, so do get in touch, and through our Street Coordinators we will do what we can to assist you.

During lockdown scams and frauds have run rife, and NHW are warning that we should not expect these to go away, we will have to learn to live with them. They come in many guises but all ultimately have the same ending - to get hold of your personal details, and steal your money. The surest way to protect yourself is not to take at face value any email or telephone call, don't use any links, and check it out through a different source. There are just too many to list in this article, but a regular monthly newsletter is produced listing all the latest scams, and sent to our Street Coordinators, so they can warn our members.

There is however a very nasty scam targeted at those in the 17 to 29 age bracket. A number of Ghost Brokers have been set up offering 'affordable Car Insurance'. They are either selling Fake Policies, or in some cases Genuine Policies, which they cancel soon after you have signed up. Either way the outcome is the person is uninsured and breaking the law. Be careful of a 'cheap deal'

If you are not already a member of NHW, then please give it your consideration. It is free to join, and there are no membership renewal charges. A NHW street or area is shown to be a much safer place to live, and if we could project that to cover the whole of Eye & Eye Green we are certain lives would improve. You may also find you qualify with a discount on your house insurance. We need more Street Coordinators, so if you are interested in helping your immediate community, please get in touch.

As our community groups start up again, and programmes are being drawn up, if you would like a presentation on 'Scams and How to Avoid Them', I am always willing to come for free if it is in the village.

## **BERYL EDGAR'S 100TH BIRTHDAY**

Beryl, who used to go to the Friendship Club prior to lockdown was 100 years old on 19th May. Beryl (actual name Evelyn Edgar but known as Beryl) lives in Parnwell on her own, but with the support of carers and her son and daughter in law. She has a daughter who lives in Canada. She was born and lived in Watford until her husband died about 10 years ago when she moved to Peterborough to be near her son. ## HISTORY OF EYE

## by David Fovargue and Andrew Smith

#### The Eye History Society

A number of years ago when the Eye History Society was running many residents donated copies of their old photos. The society as an organisation finished around the time of the death of its founder and chairman Terry Brown. Although the society finished, Andrew Smith and I have kept in close contact and continued to search for rare photos and historical documents. We are on occasions contacted by residents who allow us to copy their photographs. We have a sizeable collection. Some of the photographs are very common and are displayed on several websites. But occasionally we find one or two that are a little different and some that have never be shown. We have also given slide shows to different organisations in Eye. A number of years ago the library held an exhibition of old photographs and memorabilia to which I donated some of my photographs. The library as a thank you gave me copies of the photographs they held. The photograph in this article may have been one of those.


#### **The Old Manor House**


The photograph shows the old manor house on the left and Langley's farm house on the right. It is believed to have been taken around the 1930's.

The old manor house, 66 The High Street Eye. Although a listed building it was subject in February 1976 to an argument between the local authority, who wanted it demolished to make way for road access for a housing estate and preservation groups who wanted it renovated. The Parish Council and the neighbours came down on the side of the local authority and after an inquiry in March 1976 it was demolished.



Between the old post office on the corner of Hodney Road and the cottages opposite the entrance to Cartmel Way there are no original buildings left standing. All of the old cottages that lined both sides of the High Street in the West End have been lost. This includes Asplin's Farm and barn, Smith's Farm and Nobby Wilson's ice cream shop. Most demolished during the early 60's, Langley's farm at this time would have been owned by William Langley who was a master builder. Dairy was the main product of the farm. William's son Percy when he was old enough took over running of the business and would use a pony and trap to deliver milk to the village. Percy and his wife died in the early 1960's within months of one another and although their daughter tried to run the business the milking industry had moved considerably with the big dairies taking over and the traditional milk float was born. The farm was sold and Sheltons built Cartmel Way as it is today.
